About Neale Lavis & Mirrabooka; (EA NSW Hall Of Fame)

Neale Lavis (A Eurobodalla Local) was a member of the four-man Australian equestrian team that made history by winning gold in the three-day team event at the 1960 Rome Olympic Games.

Lavis, a former rodeo rider who farmed cattle, finished second to Morgan in the individual event. Lavis, 30 at the time, was the youngest of the Rome Olympic team. Riding 'Mirrabooka', he was almost faultless over the three days of competition. He bought the horse in Cooma for £100, and after the Olympics was offered £10,000 for him but refused to sell him.

Lavis won the inaugural Australian three-day event in Sydney in 1957 and the Great Auckland one-day event in 1960. He went to England in 1960 and competed successfully in jumping, fox-hunting and team events in Surrey, White City, and Badminton.

Lavis competed again at the 1964 Tokyo Olympic Games. In 1999, Lavis was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) for his service to the equestrian sports as a competitor, coach, and administrator, and to the community

MRC Conditions of entry

- Entries will be open on Global 12th October 2017 8am and close 27th October 2017

Live editing will be available from 3 – 5pm Friday the 10th November and 9am till 3pm Saturday the 11th November on Global. If you don't have a smart phone/ laptop or tablet one will be available in the office for your use. A \$5 late fee will apply (payable on global)

- No change of entries on the day unless it is for safety reasons and a \$5 late fee will apply.
 No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct information, entry fees and camping and stabling fees if applicable
- No refunds will be given after close of entries unless a vet/ doctors certificate is produced and then a 75% refund will be given.
- There will only be one **PAYMENT** option payment via credit card through the Global Entries program at the time of entry. Entries MUST be paid for within 20 minutes of placing entries.
 - The FEI rules for jumping and EA addendum to the rules will apply.
 - Current approved helmets must be worn at all times why mounted

• All horses and riders competing in Official Classes must be currently registered with and hold current performance cards with EA

All riders must be currently registered with the EA or be a member of the Mirrabooka Riding Club. Membership available through nominate

Horses may only compete in each class once.

Where a class has an a) and b) section, horses may only compete in one section.

All dogs must be on leads and secured at all times. No dogs are allowed onto the competition or practice arenas at any time during competition.

This competition will be held in accordance with EA Article 17. Junior riders may compete in Junior, Graded and Height classes on the same horse.

EA Junior rule applies. A junior is a rider from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 years until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18 years

- Riders may be led only in event 6a & 15a riders may not be led in any other classes
 Prize money will be paid electronically and all prize money will be paid out by 15th November,
- you will be asked for you direct debit details on entry
 - All presentations are to be mounted unless otherwise advised

Ring 1 is to take priority over Ring 2 however we will follow draw in both arenas. It the responsibility of the rider to inform the Marshall if there is a clash.

Camping Stables and Yards are available on the ground. Bookings are essential; BOOKINGS CAN ONLY BE MADE ONLINE. Camping is \$25 per night .Show ground yards are \$40 for duration (regardless of nights), Southern Cross stables are \$160 for duration, Southern Cross Yards (deluxe) are available for \$65 for duration (Southern Cross are available for Thursday). Shavings can be ordered online for \$12 per bag

- **No tape yards will be permitted**. As per EA regulations, portable steel yards may be erected in approved areas only for \$20 per yard for duration
 - A \$10 rider levy is applicable for every rider competing at this event
 - A \$5 paramedic levy is applicable for each rider.
