Conditions of Entry/Rules

CONDITIONS

This event will run under EA/FEI rules. The Event Organiser (EO) reserves the right to change or amend the program, or refuse entries from any competitor at their discretion. All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Please ensure the safety of your children whilst in proximity to horses.

All riders must be either current financial members of EA or Bega Showjumping Club. Bega Showjumping Club membership can be obtained through www.nominate.com.au/clubs/MemberRegistration.aspx?CID114. Single memberships are \$35.00. No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct information and applicable fees for entries, camping, stabling and rider and swabbing levies.

SCRATCHING/REFUNDS OF ENTRIES

Refunds will be given up until close of entries through the Global system when made in writing via email only to the Event Secretary. Refunds will be considered by the EO after close of entries upon written submission to the Event Secretary (less a \$20.00 administration fee). No refunds will be given for horses that do not start in a class once the event has commenced.

SCRATCHING/REFUNDS OF STABLES

Stable refunds will only be given if the stable can be reallocated with the assistance of the EO. For assistance please contact the Event Secretary via email. No stable refund will occur once the event has started. For biosecurity, you must clear any stabling changes with the Event Secretary.

CHANGE OF ENTRY/LATE ENTRY

No change of entries will be accepted after 2pm the day prior to the event. Late entries will be accepted if there is sufficient space in the class & a \$10 Late Fee is paid with the entry fee.

NUMBER OF CLASS STARTS

Horses may only start in a maximum of 2 classes per day. Six bars are considered a novelty event – i.e. A horse may start in 2 classes plus 1 six bar event.

DRAW

Both rings will be conducted in draw order. Ring 1 is to take priority over Ring 2. The draw for both rings will be published at the Office and on Jumping Judge Dashboard.

It is the riders responsibility to know their draw order and be ready to compete in order. If there is a clash in the other ring it is the riders responsibility to inform the gate marshal, if the marshal isn't informed and you miss your draw order, you will not be eligible to compete out of order.

DRESS CODE

Summer dress code will be acceptable in both rings unless otherwise announced for prestigious classes. Shirts must have sleeves accompanied by a collar and tie or rat catcher. It is compulsory for riders to wear an approved properly fastened helmet at all times whilst mounted.

PRESENTATIONS

Mounted presentations will be conducted in the presentation area in front of the grand stand at the completion of each event unless otherwise announced. Riders must wear their correct attire.

PRIZEMONEY

Prize money will not be given out in any case unless grading cards have been sighted by the judge – prize money claim forms will need to be initialled by the judge or office before payment can be processed.

Prize money will be paid via EFT – in the week immediately after the event. Prize money claim forms will be given to all winning riders.

GRADINGCARDS

Horses points will be checked with the national database and incorrectly entered horses will be removed from the class without refund. Prize money will not be awarded without this check.

STALLIONS

The EO follows the EA stallion code of conduct. Guardians of riders/handlers under 17 years must take responsibility for stallions at all times including when leading, riding or stabling stallions throughout the venue.

DOGS

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and under effective control. Dogs are not permitted in the ring or warm up areas. All dog droppings to be picked up. Please be aware the Ranger may visit the grounds daily.

ABUSE

No abuse of officials or volunteers will be tolerated. Failure to follow instruction from Bega Showjumping Club Committee members will result in disqualification from the event.

SIX BAR EVENTS

A horse can only start in one Six Bar event.

PIC IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS

Property Identification Codes (PICs) must be noted when entering via Global Entries Online.

RUBBISH AND MANURE/BEDDING DISPOSAL

Please place all general rubbish in correct bins – there will be recycling & general rubbish bins available for your use. Please use correctly. All manure/bedding must be placed at the specified dump areas –under no circumstances can it be dumped in general rubbish or recycle bins. It must also be piled where it is readily accessible or in trailers to be emptied once full during the event. **No manure is to be stockpiled against buildings or behind trees where it is not ready accessible.**

If shavings run out, they can be purchased from Candelo Stockfeeds or Southern Farm Supplies.

ELECTRICAL

It is a Showground Trust requirement that any electrical equipment brought onto the Showground is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. All electrical leads shall be at a suitable height off the ground to ensure the safety of all persons on the Showground.

SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT

It is a Bega Showground Trust requirement that all persons or organisations participating in the event must comply with all the requirements of the Occupational Health & Safety Act 2000 together with all other local, state and federal regulations.

The EO shall address and act upon all safety issues at the event. Due to insurance issues and in the interest of all equestrian events, including showjumping, your attention to safety and cooperation with ground staff is requested.

Participants are not permitted to camp, park or construct yards in the Hendra sectioned off Biosecurity Area at the rear of the Showground, adjacent to the Lagoon. For information regarding EA NSW's Hendra Vaccination Policy go to their website. Information is also available on harm minimisation strategies from the Department of Primary Industries website.

Competitors must ensure that all animals brought on to the Showground are free from any contagious or infectious disease.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Neither the EO nor the venue owner or lessees, nor any of their staff or agents shall be in any way liable for accident, injury, damage, loss or any matter that may happen for any causes or circumstances whatsoever, to exhibitors, competitors or members or their agents, or to anyone on the grounds or to any animal or article exhibited or to any property brought onto the grounds or for any loss, claim, matter, circumstances or event whatsoever in connection with or arising out of or understood to be the Bega Showjumping Cup or any journey to or from the event.

It is to be understood that under no circumstances shall the EO, its agents, or employees be liable for any loss, damages, claims or costs occasioned or suffered by any exhibitor, competitor or member directly, howsoever arising, including without limitation, losses, demonstrated provision must be made for ventilation, feeding, watering and maintaining a healthy environment during transportation.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

All riders competing at this event will be expected to have read the conditions of entry and rules. At the time of placing entries riders will be required to tick the box acknowledging that they have read and understood the above rules and conditions.

CAMPING

The Bega Showground is being hired for the event and is available for camping from 27 December 2018 until 1 January 2019. Outside these dates you need to contact the Bega Show Society Secretary. On arrival please check in with the parking/stabling attendant and you will be directed to your designated area. All non-camping vehicles are not permitted inside the showground as we have limited room.

The minimum camping fee is \$30 per night or \$120 per horse carrying vehicle for the duration of the show – any additional nights MUST be paid to the organising committee.

Camping fees must accompany entries.

On arrival you must get a camping/power sticker for your vehicle from the office. If you don't have a power sticker, you will not be able to have power. Competitors are asked to please be mindful of the surrounding residents adjacent to the showground and the Lagoon camping area and conduct themselves in a respectful and courteous manner.

RIDER LEVY

A fee of \$10 per rider will be charged at the time of entry.

MEDICATION CONTROL LEVY (SWABBING FEE)

A fee of \$5 per horse will be charged at the time of entry.

FIRST AID - Riders are reminded that it is protocol to report to the First Aid Officers after a fall. Riders must be cleared by these Officers before riding again.

STABLING/YARDS

Bookings for horse stabling/yards must be made at the time of entering on Global Entries Online. Any enquiries should be directed to the Event Secretary.

We will endeavour to stable horses together that are travelling together. Please identify your preference on your entry.

There are a limited number of yards and stables. First in best dressed.

No tape yards will be permitted as per EA regulations. Portable steel yards may be erected in approved areas only. These yards will be strictly restricted to 4m x 4m – please abide by this or you may be required to dismantle your yards.

Bookings for horse stabling/yards must be made at the time of entering on Global Entries Online. Any enquiries should be directed to the Event Secretary.

- Stables situated along Tathra Rd are \$80 per horse for the duration of the Event.
- Undercover yards situated along Upper St are \$60 per horse for the duration of the Event.
- Undercover yards situation along Park Lane are \$40 per horse for the duration of the Event.
- Southern Cross stables will be available in the large cattle pavilion shed and also other areas around the ground at a cost of \$150 per horse for the duration of the Event.
- Open yards are available for \$20 per horse for the duration of the Event.
- Build your own yards at a cost of \$10 per horse. These yards must not exceed 4m x 4m.

A supply of wood shavings will be provided complimentary. Thank you to our valued sponsor Merimbula Sand & Gravel for providing the shavings for our event.

Specific Program Rules & Awards

SERIES EVENTS:

- The Bega Showjumping Cup 2018 program includes a series for Junior Riders, Horses Under 16 points, Future Stars and Amateur Riders. **A HORSE MAY ONLY BE ENTERED IN ONE OF THESE SERIES.**
- The Junior Rider Series (Classes 2b, 9, 21)- The EA Junior definition to apply .
- Horses Under 16 points (Classes 2a, 10b, 28)- Points refer to the number of EA Grading Points on a horse's EA card as of the first day of the show.
- The Amateur Rider Series (Classes 19, 29)– The EA Amateur Rider definition to apply. Class 29 is the first round of Jumping NSW Amateur of the Year Series for 2019. Results will be submitted for this point score.
- The Future Stars Series (Classes 3a, 11a, 22) - The EA Futurity rule to apply. Classes are open to horses 10 years of age and under with 50 points and under at 1st November 2018.
- Beautiful embroidered woollen prize rugs donated by Horseland Canberra will be awarded to the overall winner of each of these series. Overall winners to be presented during the course construction of the main event (Class 32)
