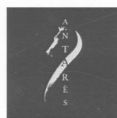

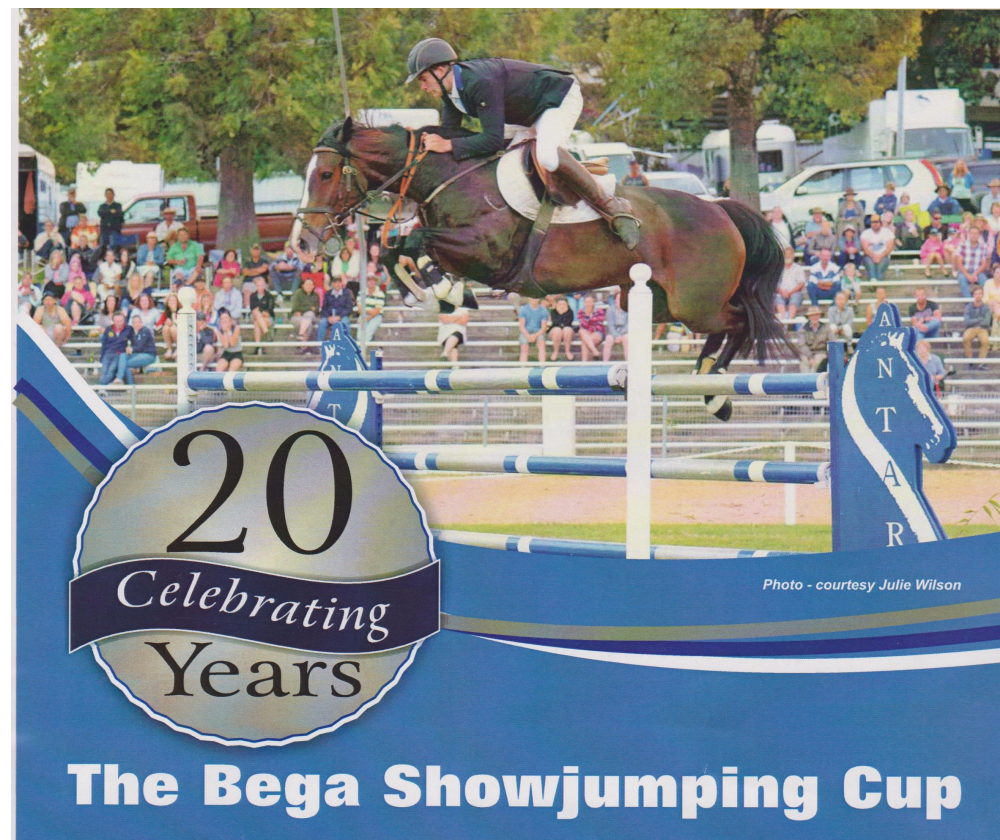

The very first Bega Showjumping Cup was held over three days leading up to New Year's Eve in December 1995. The Bega Showjumping Club had always hosted an Annual Championship but some prominent Bega business people fell in love with the sport of showjumping and saw huge potential in turning the championships into a major event on the Australian Showjumping calendar. This group of local business people put their idea to the club. The club was sceptical. In the minutes of a club meeting held on the 8th February 1995 the general response was recorded as; "...the club discussed whether or not they really want to be involved in such a big weekend. Perhaps it would be better to start off small and gradually work up to be a big weekend with big money. It was decided that a second committee be formed to run the Championships and not involve the club. Committee members are prepared to help." Little did the club know that they were going to be swept up into one of the biggest, most grand events to ever be staged in Bega. The Bega Showjumping Cup committee was formed with the likes of Geoff Williams, Anna Glover, Susie Pfeiffer, Caitlin O'Connell, Helen Slater and Noel Perry with the strong business minds and club members Richard Otton, Jeffrey Otton, Sue Smith, Graham Johnson and Chris Smith helping out with the horse side of things. The committee set themselves a huge task but just over 10 months later, the very first Bega Showjumping Cup was run and won and to say it was a huge success is an understatement.

The committee organised what was at the time the richest showjumping event in Australia with over \$30,000 in prizemoney, all of which was donated by local businesses. The event was spectacular with extensive television and print promotion and coverage, sponsor and rider VIP marquees, overseas guest riders, Australia's best riders competing for a place in the 1996 Atlanta Olympic Team and entertainment in all shapes and forms. The event attracted so many entries that the lights had to be turned on and

Nicolossi – 9yo – Irish Sport Horse – Chestnut Mare. Rider Jasmine Dennison. Very consistently placed recently in 1.40m classes including Boneo Park, Geelong and Sale. By the stallion Wirragulla Nicolas, this horse is a jumping machine!

Diamond B Vermont – 12yo – WB – Brown gelding. Rider Jess Stalling is a tireless worker, operating as a professional rider and trainer of both show horses and showjumpers from Tahmoor near Sydney. Vermont by Vivant is a very stylish, careful and sometimes tricky horse who had a very successful World Cup season in 2014 with a 3rd in the World Cup at EKKA Royal Brisbane and also Adelaide Royal.

BS On Air – 9yo – WB – Brown gelding. Rider Rhys Stones is engaged to Jess Stalling and is the other half of the very professional show horse team. On Air is a lovely horse brought through the ranks by Rhys and started competing in World Cups last year. He placed 2nd at the EKKA Brisbane Royal in 2014 and won the Mini Prix at Gawler SA and placed 3rd at Melbourne Royal this year.

Oaks Altador – 8yo – WB – Bay mare. Rider Rhys Stones. This mare is the current Australian Speed Champion and has lots of wins at 1.30m-1.40m level. She was also a winner at Bega back in 2013. Extremely careful and almost unbeatable against the clock.

Blackall Park Coloe – 9yo – WBx - Grey mare. Rider Melissa Backman recently represented Victoria in the Young Rider Trans Tasman challenge in Christchurch, New Zealand where the team won. This combination have had a very successful year at 1.30m+ level. Melissa is a very stylish rider and has educated this young horse beautifully.

Made You Look – 9yo – Standardbred – Grey mare. Rider Ron Easey from Quirindi, Northern NSW has legendary status in Australian Showjumping. Represented Australia in the Sydney Olympics. Holds many high jump records. This horse is a six-bar champion and has enjoyed grand-prix success in Northern NSW and QLD.

Simplistic – 9yo – WB – Grey gelding. Rider Ron Easey. This horse has also placed consistently at Grand Prix level in Northern NSW and QLD. This horse will leave you in suspense with his unusual style.

Cavalier Ludicrous – 9yo – WB – Bay gelding. Rider Stephen Dingwall from Murrumbateman is a professional showjumping rider, coach and horse breaker. Stephen won the Bega Showjumping Cup in 2012. This is a very well performed young horse and is just stepping up to Grand Prix level.

Dusky Farm Cavalier – 9yo – Aust. Sporthorse – bay gelding. Rider Stephen Dingwall. Another well performed young horse stepping up to Grand Prix level. Has placings in recent Mini Prix and Futurity events.

Ellesmere Derilyn – 18yo – Irish SH x TB – Bay mare. Rider Teagan Chester is following in her famous father, Gavin's footsteps as a very successful rider. Teagan also just represented Victoria in the Young Rider Trans Tasman challenge in Christchurch, New Zealand where the team won. Teagan has a long and

HORSE & RIDER INFORMATION:

Vahlinvader – 8 yo – TBXWB – Bay gelding. Rider Aaron Hadlow from Wollongong, very successful trainer and competitor once representing Australia at the Youth Olympics. Very stylish young horse placing consistently at the 1.30m to 1.40m level in 2015 including 3rd in the ACT Showjumping Cup, 3rd 1.30m Showcase of Showjumping Show in Sydney and 2nd in the 1.40m at the Riders Series Show in Sydney.

Diamond B Corsica – 9yo – WB – Chestnut Gelding. Rider Ally Lamb is a full time professional showjumping horse trainer from near Sale. DB Corsica is by Conquistador out of a King Tristram mare and has been arguably the most decorated in Young Horse Jumping Classes winning many titles between 4 to 7 years of age. First year as a Grand Prix horse and has excelled placing 9th at the Sale Grand Prix 1.60m class and being named on the Australian Future Squad.

CP Argento – 11yo – WB – Bay Gelding. Rider Andrew Lamb, married to Ally is a Gippsland Dairy Farmer. A very talented rider who has brought Argento, a horse by Vivant out of Argentina, through the grades including wins in the Futurity in past Bega Cups. Is at the beginning of his World Cup career and placed 6th in the Sale Grand Prix 1.60m event as well as 2nd in the 1.40m at Sale.

Moon Print – 10yo – TBXWB – Chestnut gelding. Rider Alyssa Mathers is a stylish rider, trainer and breeder of showjumping horses from Jaspers Brush on the South Coast. Moon Print is by Camelot Ego Z from one of Alyssa's successful mares of the same name. The horse is green at the 1.40m level but showing huge talent under Alyssa's guidance, placing a beautiful 3rd place in the Mini Prix at Sale

recently.

Bodyline – 11yo – TBXWBXClydie – Brown Gelding. Rider Amanda Lupton from the Yarra Valley, Victoria recently reaped the reward of persistence and hard work by placing 4th in the Grand Prix at the Euro Jumping Classic on her very tricky horse.

GH Tigerlilly – 11yo – WBXClydie – Brown mare. Rider Brett Clarke is the President of the Bega Showjumping Club. This home-bred mare has been winning classes at the Bega Cup event every year since she began competing including this class itself, the Bega Showjumping Cup in 2014. Last year she was ridden by Brett's son Lane Clarke and this year Brett has taken over the reins again and has started his latest campaign with a win in the recent ACT Showjumping Cup.

GH Blossom's Little Brother – 7yo – WBXClydie – Bay stallion. Rider Brett Clarke's natural showjumping talent and extreme competitiveness will see him favourite to not only win this year's event but quinnella it. This young stallion is the full brother to Tigerlilly, and came second in last year's Bega Cup and then won the Futurity the next day.

Emmaville Jitterbug – 10yo – WB – Brown gelding. Rider Clint Beresford is a local favourite, born and bred in Bega and currently living in Canberra working as a farrier and coach. Clint has had a very successful past couple of years with this horse including winning Champion Young Rider at Sydney Royal in 2013, Champion Horse of the Sydney Royal Show in 2014 and winning the prestigious Futurity at SIEC. This very stylish horse is coming back slowly from a long injury-induced lay-off and has good form in lower events in the lead up to the Bega Cup including a win in the Mini Prix and Six Bar at Sale recently. This horse is also on the 2016 Rio Squad and Generation Next Olympic Squad.

SL Donato – 8yo – WB – Grey gelding. Rider Clint Beresford has been pleasantly surprised by this young horse's limitless scope when he was stepped up to Grand Prix level exactly 12 months ago. Clint started this horse by Daley K in the Bega Cup last year and jumped out of his skin. He has had a very successful year winning the Ruby Series Grand Prix at the Australian Showjumping Championships and placing 7th in his first World Cup start at Tamworth with just 4 faults. This horse is also named on the Australian Emerging Talent Squad.

Fifa La Viva – 11yo – Stock Horse x TB – Palomino mare. Rider Craig Matthews has legendary status in his home town of Bega as he is very successful in many sporting arena's. Craig has developed a great partnership with this small mare by King Tristram. They had their first start in the Bega Cup last year and placed 6th. The pair have had a great lead-up, narrowly missing out on Leading Part 2 horse at Melbourne Royal, 7th in the Mini Prix at Sale and 3rd in the 1.35m at the Sydney SJ Championships.

Anigrey – 10yo – WBXTB – Grey mare. Rider Deon Williams is also a Bega boy and represented Australia at the World Equestrian Games in Rome 1998. Anigrey is home-bred by the Williams family and is by

Animate. The huge mare has been mostly campaigned by sister Alisa due to Deon suffering several severe injuries but the pair have now struck up a great partnership. The combination placed 4th in the Bega Cup last year.

Yakity Yak – 20yo – WBXTB – Bay gelding. Rider Grant Hughes from Canberra has earned heroic status in Bega as he has been competing here successfully for any years. Hughes is the ultimate professional and gentleman and has won the Highest Pointscore Award at the Cup many times. Yak needs no introduction as he too is celebrating his 20th Birthday! What an amazing horse and a real testament to the Hughes family horse management skills.

Blackall Park Atlantis – 16yo – WB – Grey gelding. Rider Grant Hughes has ridden this horse from the beginning and he is the most sweetest old horse going around. It is nothing for him to cart Grant's daughter's around lower classes and a Dressage test and then come out and win the Grand Prix Showjump at any show. Atlantis, by Daley K, is winning consistently now as he ever has.

Rosthewaite Vigilante II – 10yo – WBXTB – Chestnut gelding. Rider James Arkins is one of the most competitive riders competing on the World Cup circuit in Australia right now. Arkins imported this horse from New Zealand last year and the combination have a great bond with many great wins and placings which have left them in 2nd place overall on the Australian World Cup leader board. Recently the combination placed 6th in the really technical 1.60m Grand Prix at SIEC Sydney Summer Classic and won the \$10,000 1.60m Grand Prix in Sale!

Quality Euro – 11yo - Selle Franc X Irish – Brown gelding. Rider James Arkins is almost unbeatable against the clock and Quality Euro has proven to be somewhat of a Mini Prix specialist by placing well in Mini Prix events all over the country. Recently he won the Mini Prix at SIEC Sydney Summer Classic and also at Caboolture WC Show.

KS Optimus – 11yo – WB – Bay mare. Rider Jamie Priestly from Nowra has only just made her way out of the junior ranks and is proving to be a very stylish and professional young rider with a nice team of horses. This combination have been together for a few years now and have enjoyed great success in Young Rider classes at all the major shows in the country and are also very competitive in open company, winning the Mini Prix at Canberra Royal this year.

Bubble and Squeak – 13yo - WBXTBxASH – Brown gelding. Rider Jasmine Dennison from Victoria is only 15 years old and is the current Australian Junior Showjumping Champion. This is the second year in a row she has held this title! Her speed and skill will amaze you, she will not be left wondering. She has been successfully campaigning in open company as well, recently placing 3rd in the 1.40m at Sale.
